Dear Mr. Corbett:

This letter refers to the above-captioned minor change application filed by WQAM(AM) to change the transmitter site and directional antenna patterns, and the January 29, 2010, amendment.

A preliminary review of the amended application reveals the proposed nighttime facility will increase the 50% RSS limit towards co-channel station HIAA, Santiago 5, Dominican Republic, in violation of the US/Region II Agreement. To be specific, the HIAA existing limit of 18.95 mV/m is comprised of the contributions of 13.73 mV/m from CMIA, Ciego de Avi, Cuba, and 13.07 mV/m from List A station JBC, Naggo Head, Jamaica. The WQAM proposed contribution of 10.1 will increase the HIAA RSS value to 21.5 mV/m.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for thirty (30) days to allow an opportunity to amend. Failure to amend or respond within that time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
