ASSET PURCHASE, PROGRAMMING AND OPTION AGREEMENTS

The parties are filing herewith a copy of the Asset Purchase Agreement, dated October 24, 2001, by and between Channel 41, Inc., WOOD Television, Inc., Wood License Company, LLC and LIN Television Corporation. The assignor will place a copy of this Agreement in the WOTV public inspection file as well. The parties will also be filing hard copies of a Programming Agreement by and between LIN Broadcasting Corporation and Channel 41, Inc., dated as of October 30, 1991, and an Option Agreement by and between the same parties, dated as of November 11, 1991, with the Commission's Secretary, as those Agreements are not available in an electronic format.¹

The parent company of the proposed assignee currently brokers time on WOTV pursuant to the Programming Agreement. This Programming Agreement is "grandfathered" under the Commission's television ownership rules until after completion of the Commission's 2004 biennial review. Review of the Commission's Regulations Governing Television Broadcasting; Television Satellite Stations Review of Policy and Rules, Report and Order, 14 FCC Rcd 12903 (1999) at ¶ 12.

It should be noted that this Programming Agreement, entered long before the attribution of television LMAs, was for a term longer than eight years. The assignor submits that this term was in accordance with Commission precedent. In Brian M. Madden, 6 FCC Rcd 1871 (MMB 1991), decided before the Programming Agreement here was entered, the Chief, Mass Media Bureau, approved a time brokerage agreement with a ten year term, followed by a renewable year-to-year option. The present Agreement has not run ten years, and will terminate upon FCC approval of and closing on the proposed assignment. Accordingly, the assignor has answered Section II, Item 3, in the affirmative.

It should be noted that the proposed assignment also includes auxiliary licenses WEF-85; WME-771; WLE-638; WLE-623; KPG-595; and KPG-599.
