TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Arso Radio Corporation (“Arso”), licensee of station WPRM-FM, Channel 253B, San Juan, Puerto Rico. Arso herein submits an application to implement the change in channel as ordered in MM Docket #91-259. In that Docket, WPRM-FM was ordered to Channel 256B at San Juan, Puerto Rico. Aside from the change in channel, no other changes are proposed.¹

Since Arso is proposing to remain at the operational site for WPRM-FM on Channel 256B, the Federal Aviation Administration was not apprised of this proposal. The FAA has issued its Determination of No Hazard for the tower, and the tower has been registered with the Commission and assigned Antenna Structure Registration Number 1015309. It is noted that at the proposed site, on Channel 256B, WPRM-FM does not meet the requirements of §73.207 to stations WUKQ-FM, Channel 256B, Mayaguez, Puerto Rico and WTTP. Channel 255B, Vieques, Puerto Rico. Both WUKQ-FM and WTTP were ordered to new channels as part of MM Docket #91-259 and are, therefore, not considered an impediment to the proposed WPRM-FM facility.

1) This instant application should be considered independent from the pending application to correct geographic coordinates of the licensed WPRM-FM facility on Channel 253B (BPH-20050321AOE). Further, it is noted that data contained in this instant application is the same as that indicated in BPH-20050321AOE, except for the channel.

Further, since the WPRM-FM antenna is located on a relatively short tower, within 60 meters of two additional FM stations (also on short towers), certification of compliance with the radio frequency radiation levels using the worksheets associated with FCC Form 301 was not possible. Therefore, a study has been conducted to show this proposal complies with the Commission's radio frequency limits and is attached as Exhibit A. All of the remaining exhibits used to certify the information on Form 301 have been forwarded to Arso and are available for submission to the Commission on request.
