Dear Mr. Lacy:

This letter concerns the requests, filed on July 18, 2009, on behalf of Broadcast Towers, Inc. for Special Temporary Authority to permit Translator Stations K221ET and K271AP to remain silent.

Broadcast Towers, Inc.'s requests state that K221ET went silent on July 18, 2009, due to the unsuitability of the site for permanent operations, and that K271AP went silent the same date, due to a change in primary station. Broadcast Towers, Inc.'s requests include the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.<sup>[1]</sup>

Broadcast Towers, Inc.'s requests will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K221ET and K271AP to remain silent for a period not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast licenses for K221ET and K271AP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m. July 19, 2010.**<sup>[2]</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).



The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
