TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Friends of St. Simons Radio ("Friends"), permittee of FM translator station W248AH, Channel 248D, Brunswick, Georgia. This instant application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Attached, as Exhibit A, is a calculation of the transmitter power output power for the W248AH translator. An ERI FM-100-1 one bay full wavelength was used.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W248AH permit. The first condition notes that an application for station license must be on file before commencing program test with the facilities authorized in the permit. Friends acknowledges this condition and notes that it will not commence program test until FCC Form 350 is filed with the Commission.

The second condition relates to radio frequency radiation limits at the site. Friends herein restates that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of W248AH or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines.

Based on the foregoing, it is believed that all conditions on the W228AH permit have been satisfied.
