
Dear Mr. Hilliard:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 3, 2014. JCE requests further extension of the STA originally granted on October 1, 1992, to operate Station WMEN with increased power to overcome Cuban interference.¹

The Commission's Fees Section has advised the Audio Division that unpaid fee related bills for WMEN(AM) have caused the station to be placed in a "Red Light" hold status. As a result, since no other authorizations of any type can be granted until after JCE pays all outstanding red light fees, we recommend that JCE review the FCC's web page (http://transition.fcc.gov/debt_collection/#redlight) for more info on the red light rule and how to resolve it, and then contact the Commission's Financial Operations Help Desk via e-mail (www.arinquiries@fcc.gov) or by phone at (877- 480-3201), Option 4, for further assistance if needed.

We will hold further action on this STA extension request for a period of thirty (30) days to allow JCE time to file a response regarding this extension and the red light issue.
