


SUPPLEMENT TO REQUEST FOR SATELLITE AUTHORIZATION

On April 28, 2010, Tribune Broadcast Holdings, Inc., Debtor-in-Possession (“TBH-DIP”), the licensee of WTTV(TV), Bloomington, Indiana, and WTTK(TV), Kokomo, Indiana (collectively, the “Stations”) sought Commission approval of a request for continuation of WTTK(TV)’s authority to continue operating as a “satellite” of WTTV(TV) (the “Satellite Request”) as part of request for assignment of the Stations’ licenses that would allow TBH-DIP’s parent company, Tribune Company, Debtor-in-Possession, to emerge from bankruptcy. On June 4, 2010, TBH-DIP filed an amendment to the Satellite Request consisting of maps depicting (1) the Stations’ analog City Grade and Grade B service contours as of April 2007 and representing the analog service the Stations provided until the switch-over to digital service; and (2) the Stations’ current Noise Limited Service Contours for the digital operations for WTTK(TV)’s constructed, but not yet licensed DTV facilities and WTTV(TV)’s licensed DTV facilities (the “Amendment”). Since the Amendment was filed, the FCC granted a covering license for WTTK(TV)’s digital facilities as well as a permit for WTTV(TV) to maximize its DTV facilities. The attached contour map further supplements and updates the Satellite Request by providing a map that provides the Noise Limited Service Contour for WTTV(TV)’s maximized facilities, which have not yet been constructed.

For WTTK(TV), the green contour on this map depicts the station's licensed DTV facilities. (See BLCDDT-20090930ABD). For WTTV(TV), the yellow contour on this map depicts the station's licensed DTV facilities (see BLCDDT-20060630ACD); and the red contour depicts the station's maximized DTV facilities, for which the Commission has issued a construction permit for facilities that have not yet been constructed.
