**CHANGES IN INTERESTS**

Malara Broadcast Group of Fort Wayne Licensee LLC (“MBG Fort Wayne Licensee”) is the licensee of commercial television station WPTA(TV), Fort Wayne, Indiana. This application seeks consent of the Federal Communications Commission (“Commission”) to the *pro forma* transfer of control of Malara Broadcast Group Inc. (“MBG Inc.”), the indirect parent of MBG Fort Wayne Licensee, from TCM Media Associates LLC (“TCM New York”), a New York limited liability company, to TCM Media Associates, LLC (“TCM Florida”), a Florida limited liability company. Each of TCM New York and TCM Florida are controlled ultimately by Anthony C. Malara. On March 7, 2006, a transaction was effectuated pursuant to which TCM New York merged with and into TCM Florida (“Merger”). MBG Fort Wayne Licensee inadvertently failed to request consent from the Commission prior to the Merger. This omission recently came to the attention of MBG Fort Wayne Licensee’s regulatory counsel and the instant application is being filed to seek the requisite consent. There has been no change in the ultimate ownership of MBG Inc. or MBG Fort Wayne Licensee because Anthony C. Malara is the individual with ultimate control over both TCM New York and TCM Florida. Accordingly, the Merger for which Commission consent is sought herein constitutes a *pro forma* transfer of control.

Following the Merger, the chain of ownership of MBG Fort Wayne Licensee is as follows: The sole member of MBG Fort Wayne Licensee is Malara Broadcast Group of Fort Wayne LLC (“MBG Fort Wayne”). The sole member of MBG Fort Wayne is MBG Inc. The sole shareholder of MBG Inc. is TCM Florida. The members of TCM Florida and the percentage interests held are identical to the TCM New York entity, which was its predecessor, to wit, (i ) Anthony C. Malara (70% member); (ii) Anthony J. Malara (10% member); (iii) Elizabeth Malara Hamilton (10% member); and (iv) Margaret Malara Wilmeth (10% member). The only change is in the jurisdiction in which the entity is organized, which changed from the state of New York to the state of Florida.
