Hearst owns 100% of Hearst Holdings, Inc. (“Holdings”). Holdings is not a broadcast licensee. Holdings owns 100% of Hearst Broadcasting, Inc. (“HBI”). HBI is not a broadcast licensee. HBI owns 100% of each broadcast licensee of the following stations:

Use of FCC Form 316 is appropriate for this transaction because (1) the transfer of control is involuntary because it is required by a testamentary trust, and (2) less than 50% voting interest is being transferred and 50% or more of the voting interest will not be held by new persons whose qualifications have not been passed on by the Commission in long form applications. *See Stuart W. Epperson*, Memorandum Opinion and Order, 46 Rad. Reg. 2d 467, ¶ 6 (1979) (citing *Clay Broadcasters, Inc.*, 21 Rad. Reg. 2d 442 (1971)).

As approved on August 30, 1968, by *pro forma* Commission consent (FCC File No. BTC-5687), control of Hearst's stock was vested in 13 Trustees of the Trust under the order for preliminary distribution made by the Superior Court of the State of California dated May 16, 1955, which by reference incorporates the provisions of Article SECOND (b) of the Will of William Randolph Hearst, deceased (the "Hearst Family Trust"). The Hearst Family Trust requires that, upon death, incapacity, or resignation of a Trustee, a successor Trustee must be appointed. Persons designated as successor Trustees are reported to the Superior Court of the State of California. By law, each Trustee exercises his or her fiduciary duties individually and is precluded from agreeing to act in concert with any other Trustee. The group of 13 individual Trustees is the continuing group to which the Commission granted control in 1968. It will remain as such without regard to changes in persons serving as Trustees due to death, incapacity, resignation, or otherwise, until the Hearst Family Trust is terminated by its terms and the stock of Hearst is passed to the beneficiaries entitled thereto.

On July 30, 1986, the FCC granted *pro forma* consent (FCC File No. BTCCT-19860709KP) to the transfer of control of Hearst to seven of the 13 Trustees who were successor Trustees and had not been approved as transferees in the 1968 application.

By letter of September 7, 2007, Hearst notified the Commission of the death of Raymond J. Petersen. Mr. Petersen was the seventh of the Trustees approved in 1986 no longer holding that position (six others have previously died). As the Hearst Family Trust requires 13 Trustees,

a new Trustee must be appointed to succeed Mr. Petersen, thus leaving a majority of the Trustees (seven) as having not been approved as transferees in the 1986 *pro forma* application.

If deemed necessary, *pro forma* FCC consent is hereby requested for David J. Barrett's designation as a successor Trustee to replace Mr. Petersen. As explained in Exhibit 13, the qualifications of the seven Trustees who were not parties to the 1986 *pro forma* application, including Mr. Barrett, were most recently approved by the Commission in FCC File Number BLCT-20052010ABL in connection with the acquisition of KCWE(TV), Kansas City, MO, by a licensee subsidiary of Hearst.

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
