

**Engineering Statement Covering  
Broadcast Multiple Ownership Study**

White Park Broadcasting  
Hanna WY, Wamsutter WY  
March 9, 2006

The purpose of this exhibit is to demonstrate White Park Broadcasting's compliance with section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules with respect to multiple ownership of FM broadcast facilities.

White Park Broadcasting is the winning bidder in auction 62 for FM153 (Hanna WY 277A), FM154 (Hanna WY 271C), FM167 (Wamsutter WY 282C), and FM168 (Wamsutter WY 234A), and proposes common ownership of those stations. The principal community contours of FM153 and FM154 overlap to form Market 1. The principal community contours of FM167 and FM168 overlap to form Market 2. No station in either market overlaps a station in the opposite market.

Market 1 is defined by FM153 and FM154. The following station's principal community contours overlap this market:

KUWZ, 213C, Rock Springs WY  
KYCS, 236C, Rock Springs WY  
KFRZ, 221C, Rock Springs WY  
KSIT, 259C, Rock Springs WY  
KQSW, 243C, Rock Springs WY

Market 2 is defined by FM167 and FM168. The following station's principal community contours overlap this market:

KRWT, 210C1, West Laramie, WY  
KIQZ, 224A, Rawlins, WY  
KTGA, 257C2, Saratoga, WY  
KMLD, 233C, Casper WY  
KQLT, 279C, Casper WY  
KASS, 295C, Casper WY  
KHOC, 273C, Casper WY  
KWYY, 238C, Casper WY


The multiple ownership analysis was prepared considering the above described radio stations under proposed common ownership or control, which have overlapping principal community contours in accordance with Section 73.3555 of the FCC Rules. The radio market applicable to common ownership of the subject stations is defined as the area encompassed by the mutually overlapping principal community contours of the stations proposed to be commonly owned.

Only known CP or licensed full service FM stations were employed in this study. Because the number of FM stations are sufficient to demonstrate compliance with 73.3555, AM stations were not considered. Terrain data was derived from the N.G.D.C 30-second computer database for each of the stations, using radials spaced every 5 degrees of azimuth.

Figure 1 consists of a map of the calculated markets and overlapping stations.

Market 1 includes a total of 7 FM stations and, White Park Broadcasting will own 2. Market 2 includes a total of 10 FM stations, and White Park Broadcasting will own 2.

Based on the above analysis, it is believed that the proposed common ownership of stations complies with Section 73.3555 of the Commission's Rules.
