Juab County, Utah filed for the above listed television channels in the 2009 filing window to serve three small Rural Communities. Presently these towns have no direct digital reception either from a primary station or a TV translator station.

Juab County has constructed a new building and tower and will be ready to turn these stations on within two weeks. It is the county's desire to add one more station to this site.

Therefore, Juab County Requests Temporary Authority to add one more TV translator station to this site on channel 25 which will also be located within the 75-mile exclusion but only 7 miles within the excluded area.

Susan Hansen has run a Longley-Rice program for us to insure no interference would be generated to any other viewers if this STA were granted. Free-Over-The-Air digital signals would then provide a full compliment of programming to these small rural towns.

Time is of the essence as winter is almost upon us.
