This proposed DTV flash cut for the noted facility would not have a significant environmental impact since it is for an existing communication facility at an established, communication site. We do reduce or terminate power completely when working around this translator or its antennas. We also have the permission of the other site tenants to reduce their power or terminate their services when working in and around the antennas which they employ. Our transmit antenna is at an elevation, above steeply sloped ground, that yields only very negligible amounts of radio frequency electromagnetic radiation at ground level. The translator output power will not be increased from the currently authorized analog facility, so there will not be any additional electromagnetic radiation than is currently emitted.
