Dear Mr. Kinney:

This is in reference to the request filed on September 7, 2017. HMG requests a further extension of the STA granted on June 7, 2016, to continue operating with parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 301 application to modify the licensed facility.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, HMG states that it plans to file the application to change from DA to ND since unable to resolve problems caused by the nearby large power lines.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and HMG may continue to operate with parameters at variance using reduced power while maintaining all monitor points within licensed limits. HMG must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure

guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. HMG must file the 301 application or submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations per BL-19990729DE (if all operating problems are resolved).

This authority expires on **March 28, 2019**.
