- One:** The name of the corporation is "CENTRO CULTURAL DE MEXICO EN EL CONDADO DE ORANGE".
- Two:** A. This corporation is a non-profit mutual benefit corporation organized under the Non-profit Mutual Benefit Corporation Law. The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under such law.
- B. The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed is to promote an understanding and an awareness of the Mexican culture, history, arts, and traditions and to develop participation and enjoyment of same through cooperation with the Mexican Government, Mexican and local educators, writers, artisans, artists, musicians, actors and other appropriate public and private agencies and individuals.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.
