Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed October 29, 2010, on behalf of Univision Radio License Corporation ("Univision"). Univision requests special temporary authority ("STA") to operate Station KLNO¹ with increased digital effective radiated power ("ERP"), pursuant to the Media Bureau's January 25, 2010, *Order* in MM Docket No. 99-325 ("*Order*").

Our review indicates that STA is unnecessary. Univision requests STA for digital ERP of -14 dBc². Pursuant to the provisions of the Order, with the exception of grandfathered, super-power stations, FM licensees may increase digital ERP to -14 dBc or less without prior authority from the Commission, provided that a Digital Notification is filed via the CDBS e-filing system within 10 days after commencement of operation with the increased digital power.

Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY DISMISSED. Within 10 days after commencement of operation with increased digital ERP, Univision should file a Digital Notification as discussed above.³

¹ KLNO is licensed for operation on Channel 231C with ERP of 100 kW (Max-BT, H&V) and antenna height above average terrain ("HAAT") of 485 meters. Construction Permit BPH-20080422AAT authorizes relocation of the transmitter and an increase in HAAT to 574 meters.

² Decibels relative to analog carrier

³ In light of the action taken herein, Univision may seek refund of the STA filing fee from the Commission.
