KLZY(FM), Fairmead, California (FIN: 18854)**


Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), the licensee of noncommercial FM radio station KLZY, Fairmead, California and pursuant to Section 73.1680 of the Commission's rules, this letter is to request Special Temporary Authority to operate KLZY with a temporary antenna.

On December 2, 2012, KLZY experienced a catastrophic failure of its transmitter controller circuit. KLZY was able to use its back up auxiliary temporarily. However, in an effort to improve our signal coverage, EMF was able to switch to a Jampro JAHD-1/1(1) single-bay panel antenna and 1kw transmitter that was borrowed from a co-located station to increase the signal beyond what the auxiliary is authorized. EMF is maintained the contour within KLZY's licensed contour. The specifics of the borrowed antenna are, the Jampro antenna is mounted approximately 23 meters above ground level, and its ERP of 1,844 watts is about 5% of its licensed power. It is a directional (panel) antenna, and it is oriented at approximately 190 degrees true.

EMF is a noncommercial educational licensee, therefore no filing fee is being submitted with this request. EMF certifies that neither it nor any party to this request is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
