Dear Mr. Rahmlow:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 6, 2021. MCI requests a further extension of the STA granted on April 30, 2019, to continue operating with nighttime parameters at variance to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, MCI states that additional time will be needed to finish repairs to the damaged nighttime sampling system, and then file the application to update all operating parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and MCI may continue to operate with nighttime DA parameters at variance and/or with reduced power to maintain monitor points within licensed tolerances (with no change to the licensed daytime operation). MCI must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are

received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See 47 CFR §1.1310.* MCI must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date an FCC Form 302 application was filed to make necessary changes to the operating parameters, as is normally required when the sampling system has been damaged.

This authority expires on **November 30, 2021.**
