ORDER APPROVING ABANDONMENT

On August 8, 2011 the Trustee filed his Notice Of Proposed Abandonment Of JLA Media And Publications, LLC Shares to Debtor; And Opportunity For Hearing [Document No. 43] and duly mailed said Notice to creditors and parties in interest, which gave the Debtors, Creditors and Parties In Interest fifteen (15) days from said filing date within which to timely file objections to the proposed abandonment and if no timely objections were filed the abandonment would be final on August 24, 2011. The Court notes that a response to the proposed abandonment was filed on August 25, 2011 by Rev. Arthur D. abandon the Estate's interest in JLA Media And Publications, LLC Shares to James L. Ahlemann, Debtor.
