Educational Purposes

Harvest Baptist Church is a nonprofit organization that has been a member of its community for over three years. As a viable member of the community, Harvest Baptist Church has both knowledge of and an interest in the cultural, moral, social, and religious issues faced by its community. Certainly one of the main objectives as a church has been to educate children, teens, and adults alike on these issues and how to live meaningful and productive lives in the face of life's challenges through practical Christian living. It is this same focus on the education and betterment of the people of its community that Harvest Baptist Church intends to bring to its radio broadcasts.

Harvest Baptist Church will provide a noncommercial broadcast service for the purpose of advancing its educational objectives which include the following:

- 1) To provide educational and religious instruction, including the analysis of Biblical scriptures and the moral teachings found in the Bible.
- 2) To provide the opportunity for and to promote informative discussion and debate in areas pertaining to contemporary social and religious issues, as well as citizenship and its responsibilities, and family life enhancement.
- 3) To provide local news, sports, weather, and community announcements.
- 4) To present solutions to such community issues as teen pregnancy, drug and alcohol abuse, moral decay, education, and marital and family relationships.

In order to advance these and other educational purposes, Harvest Baptist Church intends to broadcast programming including news and current events, drama, documentaries, instructional programs and religious oriented programs in a well-balanced format to help administer to the broad spectrum of spiritual, intellectual, and physical needs of the listening audience.

EXHIBIT 2

ADVANCEMENT OF EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING

While programming will receive reevaluation and revision when necessary, Harvest Baptist Church will provide a number of regular programs to advance its various educational purposes. A sampling of the programs is as follows:

- 1) **Homeschool Heartbeat** – *Home School Heartbeat* began broadcasting in May of 1991 and is currently airing on over 600 affiliates nationwide. Programs address a wide variety of topics—educational, legal and spiritual—all of which are of interest to any parent, whether they have made the decision to home school or are considering home education for their children.

- 2) **Answers In Genesis** – Answers in Genesis is an informative radio production with speaker Ken Ham which offers the listener many resources to assist in educating them concerning the validation of truths found in the book of Genesis. We offer many online sources, interactive guides, and education tools.
- 3) **Faith For The Family Radio Broadcast** – Faith For The Family Radio Broadcast is a ministry of Temple Baptist Church and Crown College in Powell, TN; and is hosted by their pastor and president Dr. Clarence Sexton. The listener will be encouraged and challenged with powerful preaching and teaching to assist them with their everyday life.
- 4) **Daily In The Word** – Daily In The Word is hosted by Dr. Paul Chappell, Pastor of Lancaster Baptist Church and West Coast Baptist College in Lancaster California, and is an encouraging daily look at the truths found in God’s Word to help the listener in their daily life.
- 5) **Unshackled** – Real people...real life stories...stirring, dramatic accounts of hopelessness, and the hope that changes everything. “UNSHACKLED!” the award-winning radio drama from Pacific Garden Mission in Chicago, grips the heart with compelling and relevant stories of transformed lives.
- 6) **Your Story Hour** – believes that children are an invaluable and precious component of families, communities and nations. In today's world, right role models portraying beneficial decision making strategies are scarce. Children can be inspired to make sound choices by exposure to dramatized stories evidencing the positive results of developing character traits such as honesty, integrity, courage and faith. Your Story Hour exists to provide children with this exposure.
- 7) **Other Character Building Children’s Programs Include: Patch The Pirate** (produced by Majesty Music with the intention of teaching character building stories through drama and inspirational music) , **Ranger Bill** (produced by Moody Press and offering many opportunities for children to learn the life-changing stories of the Bible through radio drama and online resources), and **A Visit With Mrs. G** (Is produced with Kitty Anna Griffiths, of Toronto, Canada— who is loved worldwide for her warm, captivating style. A British high-school teacher turned storyteller, she has served with her husband, Gerald, in churches in Britain, South Africa, and Canada, and has told stories to children in many countries. In 1991 she received the degree of Doctor of Literature from Biola University, California.)
- 8) **Local News** – Local news will be provided by Positive Radio News and local interviews with area leaders and community minded information.
