Dear Mr. Folliard:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 12, 2013. Mapleton requests extension of the STA originally granted on December 20, 2012, for operation with parameters at variance or parameters adjusted to the moment method parameter values while maintaining monitoring points within license limits.¹ In support of the request Mapleton states that additional time is needed to complete a MOM proof and submit it in an FCC Form 302 license application due to repairs resulting from recent lightning damage.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station KJRB may operate

with parameters at variance from licensed values or adjusted to the moment method parameter values while maintaining monitor points within licensed limits. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. Mapleton must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.² Mapleton must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 11, 2014**.
