Dear Ms. Sadowsky:

On behalf of CC Licenses, LLC ("Clear Channel"), licensee of KXEW(AM), South Tucson, AZ (Facility ID 8144), I am providing this letter to you, as FCC counsel for Tucson Unified School District ("TUSD"), permittee of low power FM Station KWXL-LP, Tucson, Arizona (Facility ID 133181), for submission with the KWXL-LP application for license to cover the above-referenced construction permit.

Pursuant to special operating condition No. 2 on that permit, I took field strength measurements of the KXEW signal contour along certain radials, both with and without the KWXL-LP antenna structure and appurtenances erected, to determine whether the KXEW radiation pattern would be adversely affected by the KWXL-LP antenna structure. The results of these measurements, attached hereto, demonstrate that the KWXL-LP antenna structure does not adversely impact the KXEW array.
