Dear Mr. Liberman:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 21, 2014. TMBL requests a fourth extension of the STA granted on August 15, 2012, due to the collapse of a tower.¹ In support of the request, TMBL states that additional work was completed over the past six months, and the antenna system is being adjusted so that a proof can be completed to verify and changes needed to the licensed operations parameters.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WYOS

¹ WYOS is licensed for DA operation on 1360 kHz with 5 kW day and 0.5 kW night.

may continue to operate with a temporary emergency non-directional antenna and reduced power not to exceed 1.25 kW day and 0.125 kW night. It will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. TMBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. We anticipate that an FCC Form 302 application will be filed containing the new proof before the expiration date shown below.

This authority expires on **January 14, 2015**.
