

ENGINEERING TECHNICAL STATEMENT PREPARED BY WILLIAM T. GODFREY OF THE FIRM KESSLER AND GEHMAN ASSOCIATES, INC., TELECOMMUNICATIONS CONSULTING ENGINEERS IN CONNECTION WITH THE GEORGIA PUBLIC TELECOMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION'S (GPTC) MINOR MODIFICATION TO CONSTRUCTION PERMIT APPLICATION TO CHANGE CHANNELS FROM DTV CHANNEL 22 TO DTV CHANNEL 12 AS AUTHORIZED BY THE FCC IN A REPORT & ORDER RELEASED JULY 19, 2002.

Discussion

The proposed WGTB-DT Channel 12 facility will be approximately 18.7 km from the licensed WXIA-TV Channel 11 facility. Therefore, the proposed WGTB-DT station will be a DTV station operating on a channel above an analog TV station within 88 km from its transmitter site. The GPTC plans to install a precision frequency control unit on its DTV transmitter in order to comply with §73.622(g)(1) of the FCC Rules.
