

Exhibit 15 - Salt Lake City-Ogden-Provo

This exhibit is being submitted in accordance with the Commission's interim processing guidelines to demonstrate that the acquisition proposed in the instant application complies with the new cross-media and local radio ownership limits.

A. Cross-Media Limits

In this application, the assignee Bonneville Holding Company ("BHC") proposes, as a result of the instant transaction to hold the licenses of Stations KSFI(FM), Salt Lake City, Utah, KRSP(FM), Salt Lake City, Utah, KQMB(FM), Midvale, Utah and a construction permit to operate on 820 kHz, authorized under call sign KUTR(AM), Taylorsville, Utah. As noted in Exhibit 13, BHC and its affiliates have television and newspaper interests in the market.

Section 73.3555(c) of the Commission's rules provides that there are no newspaper-broadcast or television-radio cross-ownership limits in markets with nine or more television stations. There are at least nine television stations in the Salt Lake City, Utah DMA (See Exhibit A). Thus, BHC can acquire the licenses for KSFI(FM), KRSP(FM) and KQMB(FM) and the construction permit for KUTR(AM) under the Commission's new cross-media limits rule.

B. Local Radio Ownership Limits

As noted above, in this application, the assignee BHC proposes, as a result of the instant transaction to hold the licenses of Stations KSFI(FM), Salt Lake City, Utah, KRSP(FM), Salt Lake City, Utah, KQMB(FM), Midvale, Utah and a construction permit to operate on 820 kHz, authorized under call sign KUTR(AM), Taylorsville, Utah. These three stations and the facilities authorized in the construction permit for KUTR(AM) are located within the Salt Lake City-Ogden-Provo Arbitron market. BHC also currently holds the license for KSL(AM) located in this market.

Section 73.3555(a) of the Commission's rules provides that in a radio market with between 15 and 29 radio stations, a party may own, operate or control up to six commercial radio stations, no more than four of which are in the same service. There are substantially more than 15 radio stations in the Salt Lake City-Ogden-Provo Arbitron market (See Exhibit B). Thus, BHC can hold the licenses for KSFI(FM), KRSP(FM), KQMB(FM), KSL(AM), and the construction permit for KUTR(AM) under the Commission's new local radio ownership rule.
