Request For Extension of Special Temporary
Authority To Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Michael:

This letter concern the request, filed on August 30, 2010, on behalf of Cedar Cove Broadcasting, Inc. ("Cedar"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station K280EQ to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that K280EQ went silent on January 8, 2010, due to failure of the station's transmitter. On January 11, 2010, Cedar requested a STA for the station to remain silent until a new transmitter was installed or the amplifier was repaired. The STA was granted March 3, 2010, and expired August 30, 2010. Cedar's current request states that additional time is needed for equipment repairs. Accordingly, Cedar requests that the STA be extended. Cedar's request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

Cedar's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K280EQ to remain silent until January 8, 2011. **Notwithstanding the grant of this special temporary authority, the broadcast license for K280EQ will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., January 9, 2011.**¹ See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. Section 312(g).

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for

renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's towers shall be maintained. See 47 C.F.R. Sections 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
