

Dear Counsel:

The letter refers to the above-captioned application for license to cover Construction Permit BMJP-20051031AGW (the "License Application") for Station WASG(AM), Daphne, Alabama, submitted to the Commission on behalf of the station licensee, 550 AM, Inc., on October 28, 2010. We are returning the License Application as unacceptable for filing because it did not contain the required data concerning the location of the WASG main studio.<sup>1</sup> The applicant must prepare and submit a complete license application, along with the required fees, to the Commission prior to expiration of the WASG construction permit on January 9, 2012.

For the reason set forth above, IT IS ORDERED that 550 AM, Inc.'s application for license, BL-20101028ACQ, IS RETURNED as unacceptable for filing pursuant to Section 73.3566(a) of the Commission's Rules.<sup>2</sup> This action is taken pursuant to Section 0.283 of the Commission's Rules.<sup>3</sup>
