Dear Ms. Ward:

This is in reference to the request filed on July 17, 2014. EBLL requests a second extension of the STA granted on October 31, 2013, to operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, EBLL states that additional time is needed to resolve a tower registration problem before the license application (BMML-20140407ACS) can be granted.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.



<sup>1</sup> WVEI(AM) is licensed for operation on 1440 kHz with 5 kW ND day and DA night.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WVEI(AM) may operate with parameters at variance from licensed values and/or reduced power, however it will be necessary to further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. EBLI must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored.<sup>2</sup> EBLI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **January 5, 2015**.
