Dear Licensee:

In the *Second Report and Order* in the low power television digital transition proceeding (MB Docket No. 03-185), the Federal Communications Commission (Commission) announced that, no later than September 1, 2011, each low power television and TV translator station operating on channels 52-69 (the "out-of-core" channels) must file a "displacement" application proposing an in-core channel (channels 2-51 excluding channel 37). See *Second Report and Order*, 26 FCC Rcd 10732, 10749-10750 (2011). The Commission stated further that out-of-core channel stations that failed to submit a displacement application proposing an in-core channel by September 1, 2011 would be required to cease operations altogether by December 31, 2011, and that these stations' out-of-core authorization would be cancelled.

We have no record of a displacement application proposing an in-core channel having been submitted for the above-referenced station. Therefore, effective January 1, 2012, the license for the above-referenced station IS CANCELLED and the call letters ARE DELETED.
