Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the above-referenced Class A television station that was licensed to Fort Smith 46, Inc. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,<sup>1</sup> provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that KRBF-CA has been silent since March 26, 2008.<sup>2</sup> Accordingly, the license for KRBF-CA IS HEREBY CANCELLED and the call sign IS DELETED.
