RESOLUTION 2013-25

WHEREAS, the Calhoun County 9-1-1 Board of Commissioners is the governing body of the Calhoun County 9-1-1 District, a legal and political subdivision of the State of Alabama, with the authority and powers necessary to establish, operate, maintain, and replace the emergency communication system in Calhoun County, Alabama pursuant to the Code of Alabama 1975 Section 11-98-4, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Calhoun County 9-1-1 Board of Commissioners is the governing body of the Calhoun County 9-1-1 District, a non-commercial public authority engaged in the business of public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Calhoun County 9-1-1 District is desirous of providing community information and emergency alerts and notifications in the interest of public safety; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) permits Low Power FM (LPFM) services for noncommercial educational entities and public safety and transportation organizations; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Calhoun County 9-1-1 Board of Commissioners voted unanimously on October 24, 2013 to seek two (2) FCC licenses, on behalf of Calhoun County 9-1-1 District, for the purpose of operating Low Power FM (LPFM) radio stations for the benefit of the citizens of Calhoun County, Alabama.
