Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to low power television station KCAZ-LP, Columbus, Nebraska. Section 312(g) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended,¹ provides that:

If a broadcasting station fails to transmit broadcast signals for any consecutive 12-month period, then the station license granted for the operation of that broadcast station expires at the end of that period, notwithstanding any provision, term or condition of the license to the contrary . . .

Commission records indicate that KCAZ-LP has been silent since November 12, 2007.² Accordingly, the license for KCAZ-LP IS HEREBY CANCELLED and the call sign IS DELETED.
