

STA EXHIBIT 12

Presently applicant provides a non-commercial educational public radio service to the Florida Keys via a series of FM translators rebroadcasting Station WLRN-FM. Applicant has been authorized to construct a new non-commercial educational FM station, Station WHWY, Marathon, Florida and ultimately will replace much of the non-commercial educational translator service with primary radio service from Station WHWY.

Presently, Station W202BO is the only source of over-the-air National Public Radio programming in Key West. On Friday January 27, 2006, Station W202BO ceased its operations due to interference to a full power non-commercial educational FM station. The requested STA is to permit W202BO to resume operations on an FM Channel which will not interfere with full power radio service. This will permit applicant to continue serving Key West while the Marathon FM station is being constructed. It is applicant's intention to complete construction of WHWY within a year. At that time, an FM translator in Key West should no longer be necessary.
