By letter dated May 16, 2011, WAGV(TV), Harlan, Kentucky (Facility ID No. 37809) (“WAGV”), notified the Commission of its silent status due to severe damage sustained by the WAGV transmitter in a storm on May 7, 2011. By this letter, WAGV requested authority to remain silent until repairs to the antenna could be completed. At that time, the Licensee anticipated that the repairs would be completed within 10 to 15 days.

The Licensee subsequently requested Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to remain silent for an additional 90 days in FCC File No. BLSTA-20110517ACP. The Licensee’s consulting engineers required additional time to make repairs due to frequent, strong storms and high winds at the transmitter site. Repairs to the antenna were also delayed due to the remoteness of the transmitter site.

The Licensee, working with the antenna manufacturer and consulting engineers, has now finished repairs to a portion of the antenna using temporary equipment. With the repairs, WAGV is now able to operate at reduced power—more specifically, 40 kW Effective Radiated Power. The Licensee requests STA to operate at the parameters described herein for 6 months while the Licensee works to purchase and install a permanent antenna for WAGV.

The public interest will be served by granting this request as a portion of WAGV’s viewing audience will have its service restored for the first time since May 7, 2011. The attached map prepared by the consulting engineer demonstrates that a significant portion of WAGV’s 41 dBu contour is restored by operating at reduced power as described herein.
