We have been in contact with the Allison Translator Association which is the licensee of K02HM. We have discovered that the translator has been off over 2 years and there are no plans to put it back on the air. The association had contacted the broadcaster in New Mexico, KOAT seeing if they would take over the license and transmitter. KOAT declined to do so. We would ask the FCC would grant us a construction permit with the stipulation we could not interfere with K02HM if it ever came back on the air. Thank you for your consideration of this.
