

Educational Program and Use of Station

Living Faith Fellowship and Outreach Ministries, Inc. of Elkhart, Indiana, is a non-stock, non-profit corporation chartered under the laws of the State of Indiana, and is tax-exempt pursuant to Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. It is a nonprofit educational and religious corporate entity, which includes a church, Living Faith Fellowship of Elkhart, located in that community.

The purpose and objectives of Living Faith Fellowship and Outreach Ministries, Inc., are to educate people about the source of local social problems, such as drug and alcohol abuse, crime, teenage pregnancy, depression and suicide, the failure of marriages and the breakdown of the family. Our teaching efforts focus on how to keep problems such as these from arising, how to identify these problems when they do arise and hope then to successfully overcome them. In addressing these issues, we often feature teachers who have suffered and overcome similar problems, and who therefore can use their personal experienced to guide and give hope to others. We offer regular classes and study groups, as well as private counseling sessions to help individuals, couples or families who are confronting these types of problems in their daily lives. We also visit local hospitals, counsel and study with those in prison.

Living Faith Fellowship and Outreach Ministries, Inc. was incorporated in the state of Indiana on September 13, 1994 (see attached). Since that time the organization has been involved in extensive educational programs involving many key areas of community interest and need, including:

- General counseling
- Marital and pre-marital counseling
- Family counseling
- Drug, nicotine and alcohol abuse counseling
- Systematic education to families regarding parenting, youth and child-raising issues
- Children's development programs
- Gathering young people in groups to discuss issues of concert to them
- Counseling and education regarding people with disabilities Programs have directly worked with people with disabilities, as well as other people regarding how to help the disabled.
- Counseling in financial management and budgeting
- Life skills
- Career counseling
- Management and leadership skills
- Men's meetings
- Biblical principles of life

The organization has proven its competency regarding these issues relevant to the local community. In addition, the organization has also conducted elements

of all the above programs in both Spanish and Chinese to the local Hispanic and Chinese populations.

The proposed NCE FM station would allow the organization to expand its program in all the above areas to a much greater constituency than we have with operation of a LPFM. We have received positive feedback from the community concerning the LPFM. We hope that by broadening our signal we will be able to reach and teach more people before a crisis erupts in their lives. We have found particularly good success in reaching at-risk youth. The station therefore will be used to advance our objectives by presenting teachings and discussions dealing with these specific problems, together with teachings, music and other programs designed to help people understand how to generally deal with themselves and others.

It will be our policy to provide the highest quality programming possible, stressing spiritual and moral values. Our programming will be in good taste and suitable for listeners of all ages. Moreover, our goal is to allow our programming to be responsive to the new problems, needs and interest that arise in the local community to effectively fulfill our educational goals. All station operations will be conducted on a non-commercial basis.
