## **Request for Authority to Use Post-Transition Facility**

Sunflower Broadcasting, Inc. (“Sunflower”), licensee of the above-referenced television satellite stations, hereby requests Special Temporary Authority (STA) to commence operations on February 18, 2009 on the stations’ authorized post-transition channels. Each of the Stations was authorized by the Commission to flash-cut to digital on the channels on which they provide analog service. Because those channels are currently used for analog operations, and these satellite stations are in rural areas of Western Kansas, operation of these stations in digital will not result in impermissible interference to any other station. For each of these stations, their post-transition digital facility will serve a larger population than their pre-transition analog facility.

On January 16, 2009, Sunflower notified the Commission that it would terminate analog broadcasting on these stations on February 17, 2009. Sunflower has been airing viewer notifications of the impending transition to digital operation on these stations since then in accordance with the requirements established in *Third Periodic Review of the Commission’s Rules and Policies Affecting the Conversion to Digital Television*, 23 FCC Rcd 2994 (2007). At least 120 such notifications will be aired by February 17. Pursuant to the Commission’s Public Notice released on February 5, 2009,<sup>1</sup> Sunflower will file additional notifications concerning the cessation of analog service and will broadcast additional “crawls” in the week before February 17.
