Please accept this response to the above-referenced letter dated March 29, 2017, from James D. Bradshaw, Deputy Chief of the Audio Division of the Media Bureau, with respect to complaints of interference claimed to be caused by FM Translator Station W221DG.

Operation of W221DG was suspended (taken off the air) on February 6, 2017 pending further consideration of the validity of the interference complaints and how best to address them. Notification was filed with the Commission on February 7, 2017, and is available in CDDBS at:

While the translator is silent, it is impossible for it to cause interference. Likewise, we cannot investigate reports of interference until operation resumes, as at present, no interference exists. We are currently evaluating various options available, including, but not limited to, applying to modify the facility. If/when operation resumes with currently-authorized facilities, we would then be in a position to investigate interference complaints. But at this point in time, an investigation is neither possible nor warranted as no interference is being caused.
