**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus"), licensee of FM translator station W237DE, Channel 237D, Harrisburg, Pennsylvania.<sup>1</sup> Cumulus holds an outstanding permit to make minor changes to W237DE (BPFT-20080310ADG). This application seeks a license to cover the outstanding permit. Attached as Exhibit A is a calculation of the transmitter power output for the W237DE translator.

There are two special operating conditions/restrictions listed on the W237DE permit. The first condition regards the tower on which the W237DE antenna system is installed. The W237DE antenna system is mounted on an existing tower which is neither base insulated nor detuned.

The second condition states that Cumulus will reduce the power of W237DE or cease operation to insure persons with access to the site are not exposed to radio frequency radiation levels above the limits. Cumulus herein restates that it will, in cooperation with other tower users, reduce the power of W237DE or cease operation, as necessary, to insure that persons having access to the tower will not be exposed to radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC's guidelines. Based on the foregoing, it is believed all conditions have been satisfied.
