TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

McNeese State University ("MSU"), a member of the University of Louisiana System, is filing an application with your agency for a new noncommercial educational FM radio station.

The Board of Supervisors of the University of Louisiana System has ultimate responsibility for the supervision of its member institutions.

With respect to Section 73.7003(b)(2), no member of the Board of Supervisors of the University of Louisiana System has an attributable interest in AM or FM broadcast properties having a principal community service signal contour that overlaps the principal community signal contour of MSU's application for which it has claimed "diversity points." MSU also has claimed points for being "locally established."

The Board of Supervisors of the University of Louisiana System understands its obligation to maintain diversity and localism representations MSU has made to the Federal Communications Commission over the required four-year operational holding period. Accordingly, appointing officials and board members, both current and future, shall be notified in writing of the need to act consistently with those representations. This will be done to ensure that the appointments they make are consistent with those representations through the four-year operational holding period.
