TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Telesouth Communications, Inc. ("TCI"), licensee of station WKBB, Channel 265C3, West Point, Mississippi. TCI herein proposes to change the community of license of WKBB from West Point, Mississippi to Mantee, Mississippi, as well as upgrade to Channel 265C2, using the one-step application procedure, as outlined in MB Docket #05-210 (released November 29, 2006).

As the proposed site for implementation of this upgrade and city of license change does not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to two other authorized facilities, a proposed allocation site for the Channel 265C2 allotment at Mantee, Mississippi, which complies with the allocation criteria and §73.207 of the Commission's rules, has been identified (see Exhibit A). Due to the shortages at the proposed WKBB implementation site, TCI proposes to address the shortspaced situation under §73.215 of the Commission's rules (see Exhibit B). As TCI is proposing to implement this change of community of license at the existing WKBB tower site, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") was not apprised of this proposal.

As indicated in Exhibit C, the proposed change of community of license from West Point, Mississippi to Mantee, Mississippi is mutually exclusive with the licensed WKBB site on Channel 265C2 from the designated allocation site (which is different than the proposed implementation site); meets the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements; will deliver a signal over all of Mantee, Mississippi; and a review of the gain and loss of service areas shows this proposal is in the public interest. Therefore, this proposal meets the Commission's technical rules for a city of license change.

All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to TCI and is available to the Commission upon request.¹
