

actual interference will occur due to intervening terrain, lack of population or such factors as may be applicable." In this particular case, as shown in this exhibit, it is clearly evident that there is a "lack of population" as defined in 47 CFR 1204(d) thus allowing this translator to operate at this proposed location.

Given the reasons outlined above, the waiver of 47 CFR 74.1204 with regards to 47 CFR 74.1204(d) would appear to stand in the public interest as it would increase the coverage area of a radio facility in this area and impose no hardship to the referenced facility, WQSU, Selinsgrove, PA.
