

## **Appendix H**

### **Houston, Texas DMA**

The triggering of the Commission's local radio ownership rule, 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3555(a), and the radio-television cross-ownership rule, 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3555(c), due to the attributable, non-controlling interests of certain parties to the Transferee will not have any adverse effect on the multiplicity of media voices in the Houston, Texas area because, as demonstrated herein, the area's residents have access to a large variety of local broadcast and non-broadcast media.

The Houston, Texas, Designated Market Area (the "Houston DMA") is ranked as the tenth largest market in the nation by Nielsen Media Research. 1/ As set forth in Table H-1 hereto, the Houston-Galveston Arbitron Metro radio market has 15 independent television voices and 44 independent media voices, as calculated pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 73.3555(c)(3), far in excess of the eight independent television voices and 20 independent media voices required for a two television/six radio station combination.

The Houston DMA has a total of 17 commercial and non-commercial full-power television stations. 2/ These 17 television stations include affiliates of ABC, CBS, NBC, FOX and PBS, as well as four independent stations. 3/ Both before and after consummation of the proposed transaction, these 17 television stations will be owned by 15 different entities. 4/

In addition to the full-power television stations, there are 16 low-power television stations (including two Class A stations) in the Houston DMA, many of which provide additional programming to viewers, including, for example, an Azteca network affiliate (KHMV-CA, Houston), a LAT TV network affiliate (KCVH-LP, Houston), and a Multimedios network affiliate (KHLM-LP, Houston) all of which provide Spanish-language programming. <sup>5/</sup>

The Houston DMA also is served by a vibrant and diverse radio market, including 44 FM stations and 27 AM stations. <sup>6/</sup> The radio services available to residents include Spanish-language programming (*e.g.*, KLAT(AM), Houston), religious programming (*e.g.*, KTEK(AM), Alvin), news programming (*e.g.*, KTRH (AM), Houston), and sports programming (*e.g.*, KILT(AM), Houston), in addition to a wide variety of other talk and music formats. <sup>7/</sup>

The Houston DMA also is well served by multi-channel video programming distributors ("MVPDs"). Over 77 percent of households in the Houston DMA subscribe to some form of MVPD, <sup>8/</sup> most commonly cable television, which has a penetration rate of 56 percent (1,063,300 households) and is provided by over 76 separate cable systems owned by 17 different

cable operators. 9/ In the Houston DMA, cable subscribers have access to substantial programming of local interest beyond their local broadcast stations. As just one example, in Port Lavaca, 3,875 residents subscribe to Cable One, which carries over 170 video program channels, including three local government access channels, a channel that displays nothing but local photo advertisements and a Spanish-language programming tier that offers eleven premium Spanish-language channels. 10/

DBS providers EchoStar and DirecTV both serve subscribers in the Houston DMA, and both offer local-into-local delivery of Houston broadcast television stations to their Houston subscribers. 11/ Houston residents also have access to two Satellite Digital Audio Radio Services, Sirius and XM Radio, each offering nearly 200 digital audio channels. 12/

With respect to the newspaper market, six daily and 32 weekly newspapers are published in the Houston DMA, including both daily (*e.g., Rumbo de Houston*) and weekly (*e.g., El Mexica*) Spanish-language publications, as well as many other publications catering to the particularized needs, interests and concerns of communities within the DMA such as the *Jewish Herald-Voice*, the *Southern Chinese Daily News* and the *African American News & Issues*. 13/

Given the presence of strong competition and a great diversity of voices in the Houston DMA, grant of a limited waiver is consistent with Commission precedent and would serve the public interest by facilitating the prompt consummation of the proposed multi-station, multi-market transaction and an orderly process for achieving compliance with the ownership rules.
