

The licensee of KFLA has received notice that the use of a full service emission mask filter is proposed as part of the broadcast transmission facility for KKFX channel 24 that is described in FCC construction permit application to which this letter is attached. As this is in the benefit of both parties, the licensee of KFLA will permit the use of the aforementioned filter to limit the interference to KFLA to the requirements as defined in the FCC rules. KFLA will also be using a full service mask Filter to minimize interference to KKFX. KFLA will permit KKFX to contribute a maximum of .5% interference while using Full Service Mask Filter.
