

## MISSION STATEMENT FOR GLOBAL CHANGE MULTI-MEDIA AND GLOBAL CHANGE RADIO

The core mission of the nonprofit corporation, Global Change Multi-Media ("GCMM"), is to educate and distribute higher consciousness messages to the people of Tucson, Arizona and beyond. Beginning in the 1977 when GCMM was in its earliest formation stages, Rev. Tony Delevin, then located at 630 N. 4th Avenue, used music and concerts to deliver his messages to the Tucson homeless, street people, and college students under the name of Gabriel Records.

Thirty-six years later, GCMM and its President Pastor Delevin, continue this mission by expanding into broadcast media to create a low power FM radio station, Global Change Radio, to serve Tucson, Arizona residents.

Pursuant to its educational purpose the station will adopt an alternative programming format not otherwise available in the immediate broadcast area. Global Change Multi-Media's station, Global Change Radio will serve this mission by:

1. Providing non-commercial programming that is not carried on any other station in the local market. This includes alternative or independent news, progressive music artists and local public affairs with art, poetry, spiritual teachings, science, health and healing, personal transformations, ecovillage living, gardening, local environmental change, forums for discussion, and other educational programming.
2. Providing a laboratory for students/volunteers to learn about non-commercial, nonprofit radio broadcasting.
3. Providing members of the public direct access to produce audio programming for the station which supports this mission.
4. Presenting alternative and underexposed educational viewpoints, in art, food, spirituality, film, world and message music. Viewpoints of hateful or discriminatory nature, however, will not be tolerated. Mainstream music will not be programmed.
