

## WSLR-NCSA Agreement to Transfer LPFM License

The New College Student Alliance, having held the license for WSLR-LPFM since that radio station's inception in 2005, hereby agrees, as of February 10, 2010, to transfer the license to WSLR, Inc. subject to Federal Communications Commission approval. WSLR, Inc. is the non-profit organization that has provided programming, facilities, and operational assistance to the licensee of WSLR-LPFM in accordance with the 2005 Settlement Agreement between the Gulf Coast Sanctuary and the New College Student Alliance (NCSA).

Both NCSA and WSLR, Inc. voluntarily enter into the following agreement ("Agreement") to maintain and enhance the relationship that has been established over the four years that WSLR has been on the air.

In consideration for the transfer of the WSLR-LPFM license from NCSA to WSLR, Inc.:

- 1) WSLR, Inc. will reserve a seat on the Board of Directors for a New College Student who meets the requirements of Florida Statute 617.0802 qualifications of directors.
- 2) WSLR, Inc. will reserve one seat on the programming committee for a New College Student.
- 3) WSLR, Inc. will continue to offer internships and Independent Study Project (ISP) opportunities to New College students.
- 4) WSLR, Inc. will remain in a geographic area that can be easily accessed by New College students.

WSLR, Inc. currently has control over all physical property of the radio station and this will not change with the transfer of license. WSLR, Inc. will also hold and maintain ultimate control over all station programming.

This written Agreement constitutes the sole agreement between WSLR, Inc. and the NCSA in regards to their future relationship and WSLR-LPFM.
