Special Operating Conditions Statement

The Commission included two Special Operating Conditions or restrictions in Construction Permit BPH-20090930ADC for KVPI Radio, Ville Platte, LA :

1. Permittee shall submit a statement certifying that a fence has been constructed at least 2 meters from the base of the tower and in such a manner as to prevent the exposure of humans to radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC Guidelines in OET bulletin No. 65, Edition 97-01 August 1997. The fence must be of a type which will preclude casual or inadvertent access, and must include warning signs at appropriate intervals which describe the nature of the hazard.
2. The permittee/licensee in coordination with other users of the site must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

Answer to Special Operating Condition 1

VILLE PLATTE BROADCASTING CO., INC., owner of KVPI, Ville Platte, LA certifies that a fence has been constructed at least 2 meters from the base of the tower. This prevents the exposure of humans to radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC Guidelines in OET bulletin No. 65, Edition 97-01 August 1997. The fence is of a type which will preclude casual or inadvertent access, and includes warning signs at appropriate intervals which describe the nature of the hazard.

Answer to Special Operating Condition 2

VILLE PLATTE BROADCASTING CO., INC., owner of KVPI, Ville Platte, LA, in coordination with other users of the site, will reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.
