ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

WATERLOO CHRISTIAN RADIO CORPORATION

Executed by the undersigned for the purpose of forming a Wisconsin nonstock corporation under Ch. 181 of the Wisconsin Statutes, repealed and recreated by 1997 Wisconsin Act 79:

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the corporation is Waterloo Christian Radio Corporation.

ARTICLE 2

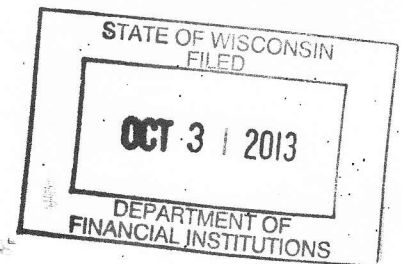
Existence

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE 3

Effective Date

The effective date of incorporation shall be upon filing by
the State of Wisconsin Department of Financial Institutions.



ARTICLE 4

Members

The corporation will not have members.

ARTICLE 5

Type of non profit corporation

The corporation is organized under Ch. 181 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
The corporation is not for profit and a Public Benefit Corporation.



ARTICLE 6

Registered Agent and Office

The name of the initial registered agent is Luke Mertins.
The street address of the initial registered office of the corporation is:

ARTICLE 7

Principal Office

The corporation has a principal office.
The street address of the principal office is: N9146 Klug Lane, Waterloo, WI 53594.

ARTICLE 8

Indemnification

The corporation does indemnify any directors, officers, employees, incorporators, and members of the corporation from any liability regarding the corporation and the affairs of the corporation, unless the person fraudulently and intentionally violated the law and/or maliciously conducted acts to damage and/or defraud the corporation, or as otherwise provided under applicable statute.

ARTICLE 9

Purpose

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax law, and including but not limited to the acquisition and operation of one or more noncommercial educational broadcast stations in order to provide broadcast programming that will inform, educate and uplift the public.

ARTICLE 10

Prohibited Activities

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 9. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE 11

Distributions upon Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the legal liabilities of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax law, and shall be distributed to Madison Community Seventh-day Adventist Church provided that at that time such entity is in existence and qualifies for such distribution within the meaning of section 501(c)(3). However, in the event that at that time Madison Community Seventh-day Adventist Church is not then in existence, or it is then in existence but does not then so qualify, such distribution instead shall be to Wisconsin Conference of Seventh-day Adventists, further provided that at that time such entity is then in existence and qualifies for such distribution within the meaning of section 501(c)(3). Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

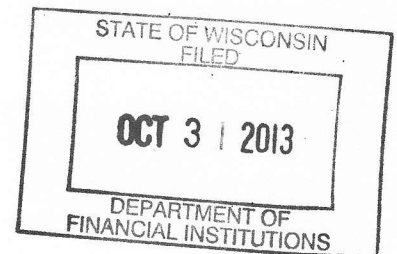
