Dear Mr. Langham:

This is in reference to the request filed November 3, 2010, on behalf of CC Licenses, LLC ("CCL"). CCL requests extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on May 10, 2010, to operate Station WKUS with temporary facilities.¹ In support of the request, CCL states that modifications made by the tower owner will prevent restoration of currently licensed operation. CCL requests extension of STA to provide for continued operation of Station WKUS during construction of facilities authorized by Construction Permit BPH-20081223ACP.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has been prevented from restoring licensed operation due to causes beyond its control and has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ WKUS is licensed to Windsor, Virginia, for operation on Channel 299A (107.7 MHz) with effective radiated power ("ERP") of 1.7 kW (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain ("HAAT") of 189 meters. Construction Permit BPH-20081223ACP authorizes relocation of the station to Norfolk, relocation of the transmitter, an upgrade to Class B1 and operation with ERP of 15 kW (Max-DA, H&V) and HAAT of 130 meters.

Thus, extension of STA is warranted.


Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WKUS may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Geographic coordinates:	36° 48' 32" N, 76° 30' 13" W (NAD 1927)
Channel	299 (107.7 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	2.6 kilowatts (H&V)
Antenna height:	
above ground:	146 meters
above mean sea level:	153 meters
Above average terrain:	150 meters

CCL must notify the Commission when licensed operation is restored. CCL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 16, 2011**.
