

AMENDMENT

RE: Assignment of License (FCC Form 314) for station WLCC(AM), Brandon, FL from Adam Lindemann to the Minority Media and Telecommunications Council
BAL-20081121AMQ (filed November 21, 2008)

The Minority Media and Telecommunications Council ("MMTC"), proposed assignee of WLCC(AM), Brandon, FL, hereby amends its response to Section I, Question 3 ("Legal Name of the Assignee") from "Minority Media and Telecommunications Council" to "Minority Media and Telecommunications Council, Inc." The addition of "Inc." to MMTC's name is a ministerial requirement imposed by the State of Florida's corporation laws and was effectuated by a December 7, 2008 Resolution of MMTC's Board of Directors in order to enable MMTC to do business in Florida as the licensee of WLCC(AM). MMTC continues to be organized under the laws of the District of Columbia.

MMTC also amends its response to Section III, Question 4a ("Parties to the Application") as follows:

1. On December 7, 2008, MMTC assigned to David Honig the corporate title of "President" in addition to his pre-existing operating title of "Executive Director." As already set out in the Application, he is a U.S. citizen, he serves on the board of directors ex officio, and his Percentage of Votes is Zero.
2. The Application as submitted November 21, 2008 listed one non-voting director (David Honig) and thirteen voting directors. It inadvertently failed to include two additional voting directors: Deborah Lathen, 1607 Allison St. N.W., Washington, D.C. 20011, a U.S. citizen; and Francisco Montero, Fletcher Heald & Hildreth, P.L.C., 1300 N. 17th St., 11th floor, Arlington, VA 22209, also a U.S. citizen.
3. Each of MMTC's fifteen voting directors has an equal percentage of votes (6.67%).

I certify that the statements in this Amendment are true, complete, and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief, are made in good faith, and are considered material representations.
