² Pursuant to a Settlement Agreement filed with the Commission on January 30, 1998, KB Prime has agreed to dismiss its application and join Television Capital Corporation of Gainesville, the only other competing applicant for Gainesville Channel 61, to become 50% owners of a new entity named Gainesville Channel 61 Associates, LLC. In addition, the Commission is conducting a rule making to substitute Channel 29 for the currently allotted Channel 61.
